Embedded Recipes (ER) is a small-scale conference that grew out of the tradition of the popular Kernel Recipes conference. Another strong emphasis of ER is maximizing human connections :

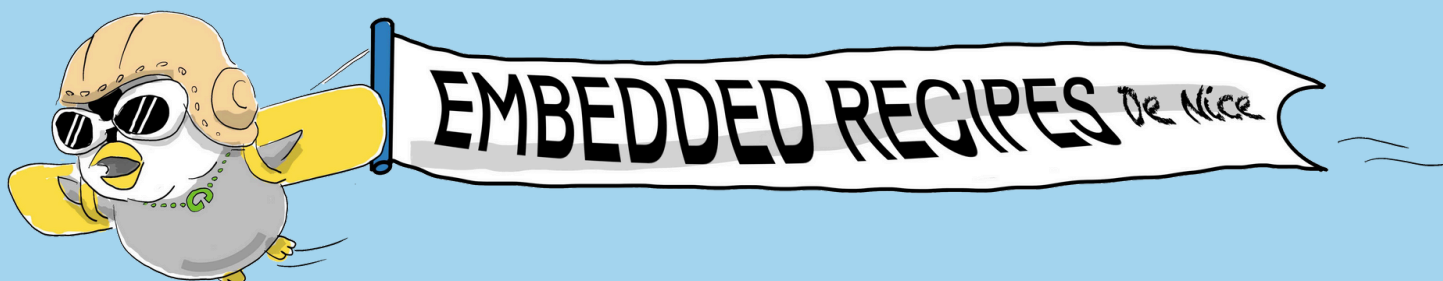
- Reduced audience : 150-200 people
